Objectives

This workshop aims to empower participants to:

- Understand the core principles of constructive evaluation in public speaking.
- Develop keen listening and effective note-taking skills for evaluations.
- Learn and apply a structured feedback model ("What was good? and Why?" and "What can be improved? and How?").
- Gain confidence in delivering impactful evaluations that help speakers shine.
- Practice evaluation techniques in a supportive environment.

- Professionals and individuals interested in developing their active listening and constructive feedback capabilities.
- Anyone looking to foster a growth mindset through effective communication.



Highlights (2 Hours)

Introduction to Evaluation Philosophy (15 min):

- The "Why" of evaluation: Making the speaker shine.
- Understanding the evaluator's role (it's about the speaker, not the evaluator).
- Brief overview of the "Could or Should" mindset in feedback.

Active Listening & Note-taking Techniques (45 min):

- Interactive exercises to sharpen listening skills.
- Practical tips and strategies for efficient note-taking during speeches.
- Discussion on what to listen for (message, structure, delivery, etc.).

The Structured Feedback Model (45 min):

- Deep dive into the "What was good? and Why?" and "What can be improved? and How?" framework.
- Examples of effective and ineffective feedback.
- Group activity: Analyzing speech excerpts and formulating feedback using the model.

Delivering Impactful Evaluations & Q&A (30 min):

- Tips for confident and encouraging delivery.
- Discussion on adapting feedback to different speakers and contexts.
- Open forum for questions and sharing insights.

Wrap-up & Next Steps (5 min):

- Summary of key takeaways.
- Encouragement for continued practice.
