- *Example:* Discussing the evolution of car fuels.

The "Good-Better-Best: Comparative/Superlative" Method: Develop the ability to present ideas with escalating impact.

- *Example:* Analyzing the benefits of apples.

Interactive Practice Sessions: Participants will engage in various impromptu speaking exercises applying the learned styles.

Tools for Continued Practice: Introduction to resources like Story Cubes, Rhetoric Game, and Toastmasters clubs.

Q&A and Next Steps: Opportunity for participants to ask questions and receive guidance on further development.
